


HSE University is developing online projects to ensure:

IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND REDUCING THE COST OF THEIR IMPLEMENTATION



Identifying the best possible organizational and economic formats for incorporating online courses into a standard academic curriculum and adding them to HSE's internal bylaws

Academic Council of each educational program is responsible for all aspects of its quality



THE GOALS OF INTEGRATING MOOCS INTO HSE CURRICULUM

improve the quality of our educational programs by including online-courses

achieve specific tasks with limited resources

1) Non-HSE MOOCs (unique content):

- a course, non-core for HSE, by a leading university
- specialized course in English
- a niche course delivered by a renowned professor

2) HSE MOOCs:

- variability and better quality of education on campus
- optimization of logistics, topical issue for universities with a disperse campus
- optimal use of resources



Regulations on academic mobility of students is the basis for credit transfer:

- The Student's Application
- Certificate on successful completion of the course
- Decision of the academic administration

Since 2016/17 online courses have become a mandatory element for all educational programs (decision of HSE Academic Council)

- MOOCs lists are prepared and opened to access by the academic supervisor
- the course certificate is guaranteed to be credited / the course is integrated in blended format (with offline exam, seminars etc.)



No set criteria for assessing the quality of MOOCs on University level

A unified University system for selecting MOOCs and assessing the quality of external MOOCs selected for integration in university curriculum

Reliability of exams and other assessments on MOOCs platforms Psychometrics and proctoring
